We are thrilled to share that the **Stepping Forward: Transforming Orthopedic Surgery Initiative** was successfully completed and implemented with more than 100 procedures performed, as of May 15. Thanks to the generous philanthropic funding, which raised a total of **\$1.2 million** from our community, we were able to acquire the Mako SmartRobotics[™] system. This leading-edge robotic technology enables our surgeons at Sequoia to customize total and partial knee and hip replacements, leading to a wide range of improved patient outcomes such as faster recovery, reduced pain, and overall well-being.
