

Transfers made by the Sequoia Hospital Foundation to Sequoia Hospital.





Gifts in action

Orthopedic

Sequoia Hospital has always been on the forefront of leveraging robotics technology in our operating room, from the purchase of our first DaVinci Robot in 2011 to buving the Mako robot in fiscal year 2024. The Mako Robot has enabled our orthopedic surgeons to perform 316 cases since its acquisition positively impacting the lives of our patients and our hospital.

Intracardiac **Echocardiography**

An intracardiac echocardiography system is an important device that provides real-time, high-resolution imaging directly within the heart chambers. This level of clarity and detail enables our cardiologists to navigate complex procedures with confidence, improving procedural success rates and minimizing risks for patients.

Sequoia Impact Grants

Imagine Shark Tank! This is an opportunity for Sequoia Hospital employees to apply for grant funding based on their experience. Always focusing on innovative and excellent patient care, some of the Sequoia Impact Grants have funded items such as Virtual Reality (VR) headsets for our providers to practice complex cases and rockers/gliders for new parents in our postpartum rooms.

Advancing Nursing Education

The Dr. William Kennett Memorial Nursing Scholarship program, awarded by the Sequoia Hospital Foundation, provides financial support for student nurses in the San Francisco State University Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program. The Kennett Scholarship Program has awarded 140 scholarships since 2005, amounting to \$1,602,000 since its inception. With the support of our donors, we are pleased to be able to continue this giving legacy by offering \$125,000 in scholarships for the upcoming year.
